1. Roll Call, Introductions and Minutes

- 2. President's Report: Jerry Simone
 - 2 Gift Certificates from HBRA to CPH fundraiser
 - Certificate of insurance and ACP has been paid for the dump and recover clinic
- 3. Coaching Status Report Chris Dadd (Head Coach)
 - Juniors Berkeley High Regatta in March will be first regatta of the season. Attendance is up.
 - Masters Ergs on T/R (14-15 people of the ergs), rowing on Sunday. No coaching candidate yet, still a few weeks away from week evening rowing.
 - Small group of juniors and masters will attend Covered Bridge regatta
 - Fundraiser at the Foggy bottoms milk run, volunteers needed
 - Sculling –Novices from learn to row are interested. Lisa will do a clinic. Laura can do sculling certifications. Group class will be June for the novice masters. Any other inquiries could be referred to Laura.
 - Learn to row good idea to continue, Chris will confirm about the day but will probably be during the summer, June 7th is the official national learn to row day.
 - CPH squads are getting ready for the spring season. Men's team has a new launch.
- 4. Safety Committee Carla Fuller/Skip Dunham
 - Use of Launches
 - O US Rowing recommendations are to always have a safety launch out at group practices. Maybe a good idea to have other volunteers if they have a boating license. Don't need to coach but could just drive the launch. These volunteers might first need to go out on the water with experienced driver just to learn how to drive the boat on the bay.
 - For dump and recover clinic, good idea to watch videos before. There was a slide presentation from Michelle
 and Jerry at Arcata community pool was on the old website showing how to get back into the boat. Video that
 Carla sent out is nice because it is useful for visualizing the procedure
